



CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Philadelphia Chapter of the Institute of Classical Architecture & Art is excited to announce the Second Biennial Trumbauer Awards, to be bestowed on Thursday, November 15th, 2018. The awards program honors exemplary work in contemporary classical architecture, design, planning, and the allied arts. It is named in recognition of the work of internationally renowned, native Philadelphia architect Horace Trumbauer (1868-1938) and recognizes contemporary projects characterized by the breadth and inclusiveness present in his work. Trumbauer's extraordinary success followed modest professional and social beginnings, and he was unrivaled in the early 20th century in American architecture for the number and magnificence of his projects. "When Philadelphia boasts of its native sons, as occasionally it does the architects among them, let the place of Horace Trumbauer be the first of the chosen," Henry Hope Reed wrote of Trumbauer.

SCHEDULE

May 1, 2018 – Release of Call for Entries

July 20, 2018 – Submissions Postmark Due (including all forms and fees)
October 5, 2018 – Winners Notified
November 15, 2018 – Celebration of Winners at Trumbauer Awards Gala

ELIGIBILITY

Submitted professional projects must have been completed in the last ten years (since November 2008) and be by ICAA members. Additionally, the project **must meet one of the two** following geographical criteria:

1. Project must be physically located within the geographical boundaries of the Philadelphia Chapter of the ICAA, which encompasses Southeastern Pennsylvania and other affiliated areas (consisting of Pennsylvania zip codes starting with 170 or higher, New Jersey zip codes starting with 080-086, and all of Delaware.
2. Project may be located anywhere in the world, provided it is submitted by an ICAA Philadelphia Chapter member.

Call for Entries

FEES

Entry fee is \$100 for the first submission, and \$75 for each additional entry by the same applicant. Entrants who complete an Intent to Submit form by July 6 will receive a \$25 discount on their first entry. The Intent to Submit form can be completed on the awards website:

Entry fee for Student Project / Portfolio is \$25. There is no entry fee for Patronage / Stewardship.

CATEGORIES

The following categories will be used as a guide for adjudication:

- New Residential Architecture over 5,000 s.f.
- New Residential Architecture under 5,000 s.f.
- Historic Preservation
- Renovation / Sympathetic Addition
- Large Architecture – Non-Residential
- Small Architecture – Non-Residential
- Interior Design – Residential
- Interior Design – Commercial / Institutional
- Interior Design – Single Room
- Ancillary Structure
- Landscape Architecture
- Urbanism & Planning
- Architectural Arts / Craftsmanship
- Fine Arts
- Patronage / Stewardship
- Student Project / Portfolio

The jury will have latitude in defining categories of projects to receive awards, selecting which categories receive an award, and in granting special citations. Not every category will receive an award. Designers are encouraged to submit projects, regardless of whether they fit neatly into the categories described above. All projects, except for student work, are required to be constructed.

The category of Architectural Arts / Craftsmanship is intended for individuals and companies in the allied arts (i.e. iron work, woodwork, plaster, masonry, decorative painting etc.) while the category of Fine Arts is intended for individuals in painting and sculpture.

The category of Ancillary Structure is intended for secondary structures to a primary building such as garages, sheds, barns, pool houses, garden follies etc.

Call for Entries

Both Large and Small Architecture – Non-Residential is intended to include all Commercial, Institutional, Civic, and Ecclesiastical Submissions.

Entrants in the Patronage / Stewardship category are intended to recognize the contributions by people or companies who have been exceptional supporters of classical architecture, urbanism, or the allied arts. They can be either self-nominated or submitted by others; and may be either an individual or organization with a strong connection to the Philadelphia Chapter area.

Entrants submitting in the student category must be currently enrolled or recent graduates (not more than five years) of an undergraduate, masters, or certificate program located in the United States. Student submissions are encouraged to have some connection to the Philadelphia Chapter area, such as the home of the project or school. Membership in the ICAA is not required for students.
